

# POOL RULES

The Oak Park Pool is a family oriented facility. All residents and guest should conduct themselves accordingly. The pool will be monitored by lifeguards during regular scheduled hours. Lifeguards have the right to refuse /deny privileges if pool rules are not followed or Association dues are not current. The following rules apply to the clubhouse, pool and common areas adjacent to the pool. Violation of these rules will result in disciplinary actions up to and including loss of privileges.

## Safety

NO GLASS allowed inside the pool area – coolers will be inspected by lifeguards

No Diving. No running, pushing, wrestling or other horseplay which is considered unsafe or disturbs the enjoyment of the pool facilities for all.

No food, drinks, towels, furniture, etc allowed in the pool

Only soft, inflatable, "beach-ball" type balls are allowed in the pool area

Pool and Pool deck must be evacuated during any electrical storm

SMOKING will only be allowed in the designated area outside the gated pool area.

ADULT SWIM – a 10 minute break will occur each hour for lifeguard break and maintenance. Only adults 18 and older and supervised infants under 2 years old will be allowed in the pool at this time

Bicycles, scooters, skateboards, etc are not permitted inside the pool area

No "cutoffs" permitted in the pool.

Only BATTERY operated electronic equipment is permitted inside the pool area.

## Guest

The pool and facilities are for the expressed use of our residents. A guest is DEFINED as any person who does not claim the resident's house as their legal address.

Adult residents are allowed up to a maximum of 6 guests per household

Residents age 14-17 who are not accompanied by a parent or guardian are not allowed to bring guest aged 13 or under into the pool. Residents aged 14-17, with a valid pool ID, are permitted to bring 2 guest aged 14 or above

Residents and guest are required to sign in, LEGIBLY, upon entry. Photo Id may be required

Residents may not be "guest" of another resident. No Exceptions

Homeowners will be held responsible for all actions and/or damage caused by their family or guest

All guests must be accompanied by their "inviting" resident at all times while in the pool area

Children should be instructed to use the toilet facilities provided. In the event of defecation in the pool, the health department requires the pool to be closed for the day, cleaned and sanitized. The offending resident will be charged a cleaning fee

Children in diapers WILL NOT be allowed in the pool without "LITTLE SWIMMERS" see lifeguard with any questions.

## Health and Cleanliness

Please deposit all trash in appropriate receptacles

No pets are permitted inside the gated pool area.

Admission to the pool will be denied to all persons having any infectious disease, excessive sunburns, open sores, bandages, inflamed eyes, colds, nasal or ear discharge or any other ailment which could adversely affect water quality/cleanliness and/or endanger the well-being of others

## Noise

Due to the close proximity of some homes and so as not to interfere with other pool users, the noise level must be kept to a minimum

Battery operated radios/cd players must be operated at low levels

No FOUL language will be tolerated

## Children

All Children 13 and under are required to be accompanied at all times by his/her parent, guardian or homeowner who will be directly responsible for said child. Exceptions may be permitted. Please contact a Board member or pool manager for more information

All children 14-17 must have a current Oak Park ID provided by the HOA to use the pool without an adult home owner present.

All parents and homeowners agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Oak Park HOA, the Oak Park HOA Board of Directors individually and collectively, any and all Board committees and their members, Carolina Pool Management and its agents, and AMG from and against any and all claims, liabilities, damages, actions or charges arising from the use of the Oak Park Community pool by any persons under 18 years of age for whom they have responsibility

## Alcoholic Beverages- Smoking

The pool area, including but not limited to both the large and kiddie pools, pool deck, restrooms, and cook-out picnic area will be considered to be Non-smoking- areas. Smoking will be permitted in a designated area to be located outside the pool fence.

Alcoholic beverages are permitted in the pool area for those 21 and over. Anyone, under 21, who is in possession or under the influence of alcohol/drugs will be reported to the Police Department, asked to leave the premises and face a disciplinary hearing which could result in loss of privileges

Please drink responsibly. Anyone that is obviously under the influence of intoxicants will NOT be allowed to use the pool and will be asked to leave the pool area if so determined, by the lifeguard on duty, to be of danger to themselves or others. Police may be called to assist.
