

2009 Pool Rules

The Oak Park Community Pool is a family oriented pool. All residents and guest should conduct themselves accordingly. The pool will be monitored by life guards during regular scheduled hours. Lifeguards have the right to refuse pool privileges if pool rules are not followed or Association dues are not current. The following rules apply to the clubhouse, pool and common areas adjacent to the pool. Violation of these rules will result in disciplinary actions up to and including loss of privileges.

Safety

Absolutely NO GLASS allowed in the pool area (coolers will be checked at entry)

No running, pushing, wrestling or other horseplay which is considered unsafe or disturbs the enjoyment of the pool facilities for all.

No food, drinks, towels, furniture, etc allowed in the pool.

Only soft, inflatable "beach ball" type balls are allowed in the pool area. Any other objects that can be thrown will be allowed at the lifeguard's discretion.

No Diving

Pool and pool deck must be evacuated during any electrical storm.

There will be a 10 minute break each hour so lifeguards can rest, check chemical levels and clean the pool area. Only adults 18 and older and supervised preschool children are allowed in the pool at that time.

Bicycles, scooters, skateboards etc will not be permitted inside the pool area. Skateboards, however can be left with the lifeguards at check-in.

Guest

Residents and guest are required to sign in, LEGIBLY, when they enter the pool area.

Residents may not be a guest of another resident. No exceptions.

ONLY homeowners and their guest are permitted in the pool area. Homeowners will be held responsible for all actions and/or damage of their family and guests at all times.

All guests must be accompanied by their "inviting" resident, while in the pool area.

There is a limit of 6 guests per Homeowner.

Health and Cleanliness

Children should be instructed to use the toilet facilities provided. In event of defecation in the pool, the health department will require the pool to be closed for the day until cleaned and sanitized. The offending resident will be charged a cleaning fee.

Health and Cleanliness (cont)

Children IN DIAPERS will NOT be allowed in the pool without RUBBER pants over the diaper.

Please deposit all trash in appropriate receptacles.

No cutoffs permitted in the pool.

No pets permitted in the gated pool area.

Admission to the pool will be denied to all persons having any infectious disease. Persons with excessive sunburns, open sores, bandages, inflamed eyes, colds, nasal or ear discharge or any other ailments which could adversely affect water quality/cleanliness and/or endanger the well-being of others will not be permitted in the pool.

Noise

Due to the close proximity of some homes to the pool and so as not to interfere with other pool users, the noise level must be kept to a minimum.

Only battery operated electronic equipment is permitted inside the pool area at low levels only (at the lifeguards discretion)

NO FOUL language.

Children

All children. age 15 and under are required to be accompanied, at all times, in the pool area, by his/her parent, guardian or a homeowner who will be directly responsible for said child. Exceptions may be permitted. Please contact a Board member or pool manager for more information.

All parents and homeowners agree to release and indemnify Oak Park HOA from any claims, losses or liability arising out of the use of the pool by any person under 16 years of age for whom they are responsible.

Alcoholic Beverages

Alcoholic beverages are permitted in the pool area for those 21 and over. Anyone, under 21, who is in possession or under the influence of alcohol/drugs will be reported to the Police Department and face a disciplinary hearing which could result in loss of privileges

Please drink responsibly. Anyone that is obviously under the influence of intoxicants will NOT be permitted to use the pool and will be asked to leave if so determined to be of danger to themselves or others by the lifeguard on duty. Police will be notified in these situations.
